

Common Code Enforcement Violations

Section title "Clean Community Regulations."

- ❖ Grass or other vegetation exceeding an average of 12" in height.
- Trash, debris, etc. which could harbor or attract rats or other rodents.
- Stagnant water including unsanitary water in swimming pools.
- Unused motor vehicles, boats, trailers, appliances, or other mechanical devices or parts thereof. Junk motor vehicles.
- Any building which is in violation of city, county, or state building, housing, or health codes or regulations.
- ❖ Any other condition constituting a nuisance under state law.
- Unsecured vacant buildings, commercial or residential.

Violations of any of these ordinances listed above or those listed in Article XXIV of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Clarkesville and/or the International Property Maintenance Code shall be subject to citations and fines per Article XXVI.
