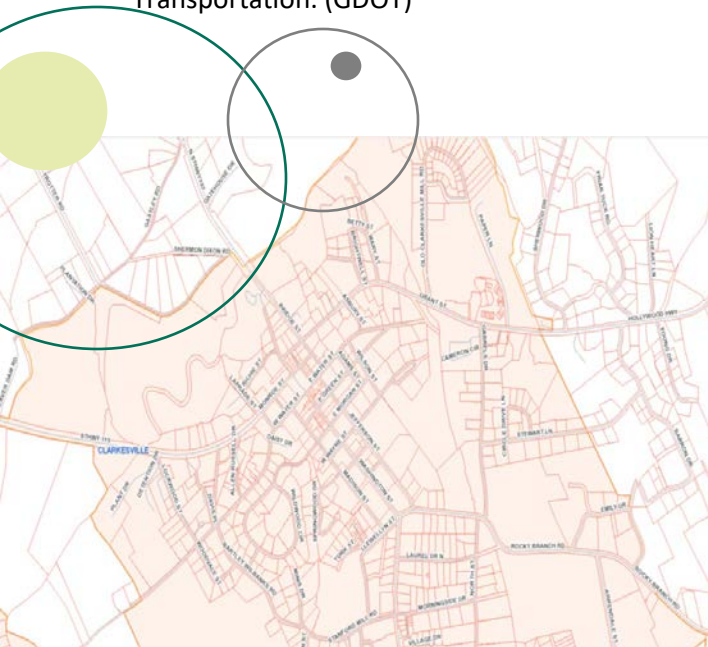


WHO CAN DRIVE?

- ❖ Those persons who are 18 years of age & older and have a valid driver's license.
- ❖ Those persons who are 16 years of age, but not yet 18, if accompanied in the front seat by a person at least 18 years of age who holds a valid driver license.
- ❖ Absolutely no persons under the age of 16 shall be permitted to operate a motorized cart on any street.

WHERE CAN I DRIVE?

- ❖ Carts shall only operate within and upon those City streets that have a posted speed limit of 25 miles per hour or less and/or are designated by the City of Clarkesville as an authorized street.
- ❖ Carts may not travel on streets & highways maintained by the Georgia Department of Transportation. (GDOT)

PTV PERMITS

City of Clarkesville Ordinance allows and regulates the use of golf carts operated on certain Clarkesville City streets.

Permits may be obtained at:

During the hours of:

Monday – Friday
8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.

Permits will not be issued after business hours, weekends or holidays.

REQUIREMENTS

Required golf cart equipment and information to be inspected by officers include the following:

- Driver's License
- Liability Insurance
- Breaking system sufficient for weight & passenger capacity.
- A reverse warning device functional at all times.
- Main power switch – when key is removed, the power circuit should be inoperable.
- Head Lamps;
- Reflectors;
- Slow Moving Emblem
- Tail Lamps;
- A horn;
- A rearview mirror;
- Safety warning labels; and
- Seat belts and hand holds.

PENALTIES

- ❖ Any person violating any provision of the Personal Transportation Vehicle (PTV) / Motorized Cart Ordinance shall be punished by a fine for the 1st offense of not less than \$25.00
- ❖ 2nd offense shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$50.00
- ❖ 3rd offense shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$100.00
- ❖ Should a 3rd offense be committed within one (1) year of conviction of a second offense, the minimum fine shall be \$100.00 and the owner's registration shall be revoked.
- ❖ If registration is revoked, the owner shall pay a re-registration fee of \$200.00.
- ❖ The registered owner or family member cannot thereafter register a motorized cart for use in the City for a period of two (2) years.
